Subject Focus Days

These are subject-specific sessions for Year 12 students. They are offered throughout the year at Leeds Trinity University, or in some cases can be delivered at your school or college. They are designed and presented by our subject experts to give your students an insight into the subject and how it is offered at Leeds Trinity. Subject Focus Days include lunch with our student ambassadors, as well as the opportunity to attend a UCAS workshop. We welcome group bookings from schools and colleges, as well as individual students. We may also be able to help with transport costs for group bookings.

Post-16 Inspire Presentations and HE Experience Events

We can deliver presentations at your school/college to cover the full range of information about applying to university and all of the processes along the way. These presentations include:

- Why choose higher education? The UCAS journey.
- Student Life (delivered by our student ambassadors)
- How to write an excellent personal statement
- Student finance
- Interview skills
- How to get the most from a UCAS Convention

Our Year 12 HE experience events are best delivered in June or July to give students time to think about their options. We can deliver the programme at Leeds Trinity, or in your school/college if you prefer.

Reward Scheme Residential

We know that some young people who have the talent and drive to go to university may not always be able to reflect their potential in grades alone. The Reward Scheme is our contextualised admissions programme, focusing on widening participation.

Students taking part will be eligible to receive 8 UCAS points towards their offer. The points will be added into their final tariff score when they receive their results in the summer. It will then be taken into account at that point, alongside other qualifications.
