What is a Virtual Offer Holder Day?

This year, these events are virtual, which means that we will be providing you with course information, resources, and opportunities to speak to academics, current students and relevant staff, all entirely online.

Things to think about before attending the event:

Throughout the event, there will be lots of opportunities to ask questions, so it is worth thinking about what you want to find out.

Do you have a question about a particular module? You'll have an opportunity to ask a lecturer from your chosen course. Do you want to know more about the nightlife in Leeds? You should ask one of our current students. If you're not sure who is best to ask, just send in your question during the event and we will make sure you get to speak to the right person.

Top tips:

Here are some top tips to get the most out of a virtual Offer Holder Day:

- **Ask for more details about areas of the course that you're particularly interested in.**
If you have a specific area of interest, ask whether this is something you could pursue. If you're unclear on what will be taught over the duration of the course, this is your opportunity to find out.
- **Think about the added benefits of the university.**
At Leeds Trinity there are many added benefits that you may want to know more about. These include: study abroad, work placements with every degree, and student support for every aspect of student life – from your mental wellbeing to managing your academic workload.
- **Ask current students for their opinions.**
Our current students are the experts about life at Leeds Trinity. Be sure to quiz them on student life, clubs and societies, their experience of studying the course, and anything else!
- **Make notes to reflect on afterwards.**
